- Can be done in 3-10 semesters
- 6 credit hours per term required for federal student loan programs

### **BSN Quick Facts**

- A student's major is declared as "Nursing Pending" when applying. If accepted, it becomes "Nursing."
- The program is limited access—this means you must apply and be accepted into the program in order to take nursing courses.
- Remember that every course does matter and all grades factor into your cumulative GPA!

## Step 1 - UCF Application


- About 3 months prior to beginning of semester

## Step 3 - Your Degree Audit

- Current UCF students can view degree audit at any time.
- New applicants will not be able to view degree audit until late February for Fall admits and October for Spring admits.
- Why to view your Audit:
  - GPA—Your cumulative GPA will always be listed in category #1, under "University Credit Hour Requirements."
  - **Prerequisite Courses**—Your degree audit must reflect 7 completed prerequisites with letter grades, and they must be listed in the correct prerequisite category.
  - Transfer Courses—If you took courses outside of UCF, you
    must have official transcripts sent to UCF before you apply to
    Nursing.



### Step 4 – RN License

## Acceptance Notification

Within 2 weeks of submitting your RN license, you will receive either an acceptance email or an email stating that admission requirements are missing. You may continue to update your UCF records to satisfy the missing documents, and the College of Nursing will continuously review your records until a month before classes start. After that, if your record is still not cleared for admission, you must reactivation your UCF application for the next available semester.

### **Estimated Costs**

- If you choose to utilize only fully online UCF resources, Florida resident tuition is \$179.19 per credit hour
  - http://www.ucf.edu/online/costs/undergraduate-tuition-and-fees/
  - Reduced tuition does not include access to most main campus resources (physical library, gym, activities, etc.)
- Books approximately \$100/class
- \$150 LEAP\*RN (Project Concert)- One time Subscription Cost for student database
- Satisfactory Academic Progress Policies
  - 180 hour limit for federal aid for first Bachelor's Degree
  - 70 hour limit for federal aid for second Bachelor's Degree
- Excess Credit Hour Surcharge



## Scholarships

- \$235,000 available every year only to students who are offered acceptance in a UCF nursing program.
