## Admission Requirements

- Must have a minimum 3.0 overall/Cumulative GPA (all undergraduate credits including all transfer coursework).
- Must be in good academic standing. NOTE: Transfer students with completed coursework at Valencia College also need to have a minimum institutional/Valencia GPA of 2.0 at the time of applying (in addition to the minimum overall college GPA of 3.0).
- Completion of UCF's foreign language requirement (by program start date)
- Earn a minimum score of 78% on the TEAS test
- Have completed a Florida Public Institution AA or meet <u>UCF's GEP</u> and foreign language requirement PRIOR to the first day of classes for the program <u>OR</u> Have completed a BS/BA from an accredited institution.
- Have completed with grades of C or better in the following courses to be included in official transcripts sent to both UCF and Valencia.
