*Please complete both Valencia and UCF admission requirements simultaneously*

***\*Failure to complete the following requirements by the posted deadlines may result in non-acceptance to BOTH Nursing programs.***

***\* Make sure to verify that you have met all admission requirements including a 3.0 Overall GPA (see Step 2 for other GPA requirements), meet all UCF and VC requirements and have a valid TEAS 7 composite score of 78.***

<p><b>D Request that <u>all</u> official college transcripts from all institutions (include high school transcripts or GED score report and official AP/CLEP/IB/AICE scores) are sent to Valencia and posted on your record.</b> It may take up to 20 business days to process transcripts, so it is important to submit as soon as possible.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>All transcripts must be on file before submitting your program application or your application will be denied.</b></p>	<p><b>D Request that <u>all</u> official college transcripts be sent to UCF, including high school transcripts and official AP/CLEP/IB/AICE scores).</b></p>

**D Submit official ATI TEAS scores to Valencia**

Successfully complete the TEAS, with a minimum passing composite score of 78.

- Scores on record may be used for admission criteria if test dates are less than two years old.
- Applicants who take the ATI TEAS exam outside of the Valencia College Assessment Center must request official scores from and complete the ATI Score Matching Request Form.
- It is recommended that the student verify receipt of their TEAS score report on their myVC account prior to the concurrent program application deadline.

**Submit official ATI TEAS 7 scores to UCF**

Complete the ATI TEAS 7 with a minimum Composite score of 78. If the TEAS 7 exam was taken at another institution, students must request an official score report from ATI Testing to be sent to U of Central FL. Unofficial or paper copies of scores will not be accepted. **Starting with the Sept. 15, 2023 deadline, only TEAS 7 scores will be accepted.**

**D Apply for financial aid (recommended)** and be sure that the **Valencia FAFSA School Code 006750** is added on your FAFSA. [Home | Federal Student Aid](#)

Students are not permitted to accept any federal financial assistance from UCF while co-enrolled.

**STEP 2**

**D Once your transcripts are evaluated by Valencia (it can take up to 20 business days) and your coursework is posted to your Valencia transcript, you will be able to view your transferred courses in your Atlas account. To view your Valencia transcript in Atlas:**

- Log in to your myVC account <https://myvc.valenciacollege.edu>, click the Courses tab, click on the Student Profile, and select Valencia College Transcript (unofficial). Select Credit and unofficial transcript in the drop-down menu.
- Transfer courses may need to be reviewed by a Student Success Coach for potential course substitution or equivalency.
- Note: courses taken at other institutions, including UCF, may not be equivalent to Valencia Nursing Prerequisites and require additional review. **Course substitution or equivalency must be on your Valencia record before submitting your program application or your application will be void.**

**D Once your transcripts are evaluated by UCF and your coursework is posted to your UCF transcript, you will be able to view your transferred courses in your myUCF account. To view your UCF Degree Audit on myUCF:**

- Log in to your myUCF account <https://my.ucf.edu>, Student Self Services tab> “View my Degree Audit”>
- **Credits from Out of State or Private Institutions:** All incoming courses will be reviewed for UCF equivalency once you are admitted.
- The Transfer Credit Evaluation is located in your myUCF portal and will list all courses received at the time of admission along with any UCF equivalencies.
- For courses without a UCF equivalent, you will have the opportunity to upload a syllabus for review.

## Admission Requirements

- Must have a minimum 3.0 overall/cumulative GPA for UCF (all undergraduate credits including all transfer coursework).
- Must be in good academic standing with Valencia and UCF.
- Earn a minimum score of 78% composite score on the TEAS test.
- Have prerequisites completed with grades of C or better in the courses below.
- Must have 3.0 GPA for Valencia prerequisites.
- Must have completed a Florida Public Institution AA OR meet [UCF's GEP](#) and foreign language requirement OR have completed a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution PRIOR to the program start date.

\*\*Effective fall 2026, all VC prerequisites must be satisfied by the application deadline.

### STEP 3

Apply between Jan. 1-15 for Summer Program, May 1-15 for Fall program, Sept. 1-15 for Spring Program

- Submit the Valencia Nursing application (select Valencia/UCF Concurrent ASN-BSN) and pay the \$15 fee.**

Applications will only be available and accepted during the application window. Visit our website for more information on the application: [Nursing Programs | Valencia College](#). **All admission requirements, including all prerequisites, must be met at the time you apply. Admission decision letters will be sent via myVC email from [HealthScienceApplications@valenciacollege.edu](mailto:HealthScienceApplications@valenciacollege.edu) about 4-6 weeks after the application deadline. In order to be fully accepted into the Valencia/UCF Concurrent ASN-BSN program, you must receive acceptance letters from BOTH Valencia and UCF Nursing programs. \*\*If you would like to be considered for both the Valencia/UCF Concurrent ASN-BSN program and the Valencia Traditional nursing program you must submit two separate Valencia Nursing applications.**

- Submit the UCF Nursing application (select Concurrent BSN – Valencia) online at <http://applications.nursing.ucf.edu/>**
- Admission decision letters will be sent to e-mails that were provided when requesting a UCF College of Nursing application.** Decision letters take about 6-8 weeks AFTER the application deadline.

### STEP 4

- You must complete the Valencia Transfer Student Orientation** if you have never completed Orientation at Valencia. **(This orientation is not the same as the mandatory Valencia Nursing Program Orientation).** Students are able to sign up for orientation via Atlas. A hold will be placed on your record to prevent course registration and will be removed once you attend the Transfer Student Orientation. **(You may complete orientation after being accepted to the program).**

- If you have received an official acceptance email into the Valencia Nursing program via Atlas email (as part of the Valencia/UCF Concurrent ASN-BSN program), you must attend the mandatory Valencia Nursing Program Orientation.** Please check VC email for Nursing Program Orientation and Compliance requirement, deadlines, and other important information. **Course registration instructions will be provided at this orientation. Must be at least 18 years of age at program start.**

- You must complete the UCF Transfer Student Orientation** if you have never completed Orientation at UCF. If you have received an official acceptance into the Valencia/UCF Concurrent ASN-BSN program, you must register for the UCF Orientation specific to the Valencia Concurrent Nursing Program <https://orientation.ucf.edu/>
- A hold will be placed on your record to prevent course registration

- All students accepted to the Valencia/UCF Concurrent ASN-BSN program must attend a UCF College of Nursing Orientation.** Mandatory program orientation details are provided in the official acceptance emails from both institutions.
